Whakamārama:

This is an operational policy designed in consultation between the Tūmuaki and the Pouako of the kura.

Pūtake:

The intent of classroom release time is to address Pouako workload while maximizing benefits for ākonga learning

The use of classroom release time will be professionally useful for the Kura teaching and learning programmes, the teachers professional growth and the learning needs of the student.

Whāinga:

This policy contains a list of the most common uses for classroom release time in our kura. The list may be amended from time to time through consultation with Pouako, Tūmuaki and individual Pouako may also agree to other uses from time to time.

- Reporting
- Observing other Pouako
- Syndicate meetings
- Any other use agreed to from time to time between Pouako and Tumuaki
- Evaluation
- Personal Professional Learning
- Reading / research
- Assessment

Ara Tohu:

Each Pouako will be allocated days according to Union Agreement.

These are to be used each term. Pouako are to complete the CRT

Application Form, gain signature from Syndicate Leader for approval of date sought, and then hand to Tumuaki for final approval. The Tumuaki will then forward details to the Tumuaki Tuarua to arrange suitable relief.
