Curriculum Delivery Policy

Te Aho Matua

‘He mea tino nui te wāhi ako hei whakaohoho i te wairua o te tamaiti ki āna mahi whakaako. Nō reira kia kikī tonu te kura i ngā mea pupuri hoki i te hā o te Māori. Me whakawhānui hoki tōna wāhi ako ki ngā marae me ēra atu wāhi whangai i te mōhio’

Putake:

We assert that the teaching and learning environment is a happy and stimulating experience for children, whānau and all other participants.

Aratohu:

- 1 All curriculum areas will be taught in Te Reo Māori
- 2 All staff who do not have proficiency in te reo Māori will be required to undertake professional development in Te Rep
- 3 Te Kura Whakapūmau I Te Reo Tūturu ki Waitaha accepts that there is an appropriate time for introduction of English. A separate English language teacher and a separate language facility will be provided for tamariki once they begin full time instruction in Te Parahia.
- 4 Te Kura Whakapūmau I Te Reo ki Waitaha insists that competence in Māori language and culture along with a commitment to Te Aho Matua be the hallmark of Kura Kaupapa Māori Poauko and whānau, but that there be accommodation for those who are still in the learning phase.

Te whakawhānautanga:

1. We are a Kura Kaupapa Māori that exists for the revival and survival of Te Reo me ngā Tikanga Māori.
2. We affirm an absolute commitment to the teaching and learning in and through total immersion.
3. It is paramount that the philosophies of Te Aho Matua are an intricate and vital part of this Kaupapa.
4. Te Aho Matua practises will be supported by fluent speaking pakeke to assist kaiako
5. The Kura will operate primarily for graduates from te Kōhanga Reo, from other Kura Kaupapa Māori and from Māori speaking whānau that are committed to Te Reo me ōna Tikanga.
